How to present your recycling

Put your recycling at the edge of your property by **6 am** on collection day.



RINSE plastic milk bottles, cans, glass

SQUASH plastic milk bottles

LIDS BACK ON plastic bottles

FIT small electricals into a standard carrier bag

NO black plastic or crisp packets

BAG UP shredded paper

REMOVE hard book covers

PAIR UP shoes
