

What to do about the rubbish – District by District

This document provides information about where to source litter picking equipment and what to do with the rubbish you collect.

Be aware that you need to have rubbish collection in place before you start litter picking or beach cleaning. Some Local Authorities may expect you to use special bags or leave it in a specific place, so make sure you know what all the procedures are before you start.

Devon County Council has some litter pickers for young people available to loan out, so contact lucy.mottram@devon.gov.uk to arrange to borrow them.

East Devon

You will need to show a Risk Assessment has been carried out and Public Liability Insurance be in place before any help is given.

Exeter City

Contact the Public and Green Space (PGS) team at publicrealmenquiries@exeter.gov.uk about any questions on litter picking. They can also provide gloves, bags and risk management guidance for all volunteers. Please arrange collection sites with the PGS team before your litter pick for a prompt waste collection.

North Devon

They will be able to arrange waste collection if you are litter picking in North Devon, unless it is from a private beach. They also have some litter pickers and hi-vis jackets you can borrow.
